



## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Start out by painting the inside of the bowl with 2 coats of Snowflake.
2. Water down some Red Hot paint with 50% water to 50% paint. Dip your medium brush into the watered down paint. Run your fingers over the bristles of the brush to splatter the inside of the bowl.
3. Paint the outside of your bowl with 3 coats of Red Hot. Allow the bowl to dry.
4. Use a liner brush to paint two horizontal lines around the bowl about 1/2 thick in Start Dust.
5. Next, paint your vertical stripes. Because the line tapers, the stripes will be thicker on the top and get thinner as they go down. We did the top of the stripe about 3/4" thick and tapered them down to about 1/4" thick. We did 2 coats of Star Dust on these too.
6. Finally, where the lines overlap we are going to paint a square of black using Licorice in one heavy coat.

## TIPS

- 3 coats of paint will give you nice solid colors.
- Make sure to water down the Red Hot paint before you splatter so that it's nice and thin with 50% water to 50% paint.
